## REQUEST FOR BIDS

The Town of Wilbraham Department of Public Works will receive internet bids through a municipal auction website on behalf of the Board of Selectmen for "Various Surplus Vehicles, Supplies, Property and Other Items", at various times throughout the calendar year 2018. The auction closing dates and times are varied depending on the item listing and time of listing. At the end of the specific item listing time the auction shall be closed.

The municipal auction web site address is: www.municibid.com

All Rules and regulations of said site shall govern, including general conditions as specified with each bid item. Additional terms and conditions are contained on the website. The site is open to all interested parties, including the general public wishing to submit a bid.

Payments shall be made by cash, bank check or money order payable to the Town of Wilbraham within 5 days of the bid closing. In the event that the highest bidder does not make payment within the 5 days after the bid closing, the Town may choose to offer the bid item to the next highest bidder. All surplus inventory must be removed from Town property within 5 days after award of bids unless prior arrangements have been made.

Bidders are responsible for examining the items prior to bidding and are therefore strongly urged to do so. Bid items may be viewed at the Town of Wilbraham Highway Department and an appointment **must be made prior to viewing** the inventory by calling 413-596-2800 x 208, Monday – Friday 8:30 am – 4:30 pm. Some items may be located at other locations, it is strongly recommended to view items prior to purchase. All items will be sold "As-is", "where is" with no warranty expressed or implied. All items are excess, surplus, salvage and/or reached its' useful life to the Town of Wilbraham.

The Awarding authority reserves the right to reject any and all bids, or to accept the bid deemed to be in the best interest of the Town of Wilbraham. The surplus items will be awarded to the highest responsive bidder offering the highest prices for the vehicles (items) described in the invitation for bids.

The bidder certifies under the penalty of perjury that this bid has been made and submitted in good faith and without collusion or fraud with any other person. As used in this certification the word "person" shall mean any natural person, business, partnership, corporation, union, committee, club, organization, entity or group of individuals.

All bidders must submit a non-collusion form.

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 62c sec 49a, the bidder must certify under the penalties of perjury that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, the bidder is in compliance with all laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts relating to taxes, reporting or employees and contractors, withholding and remitting child support.
